

Philadelphia Pattern

- The Blade has a square heel
- Can make buttering easier

London Pattern

•The blade has a sharply angled heel



Brick

All purpose trowel used for cutting, buttering, and adjusting units.



Pointing

Fits into tight places. Used to point, grout, and tool joints.

<u>Margin</u>

Used to smooth joints and mix grout.



<u>Duckbill</u>

Has a long narrow blade and is used primarily for clean-up



Tuckpointer

Used to shape mortar between joints.



Parging (Flat)

Used to apply a thin coat (parge) Of mortar to masonry units.



Notched

Used to spread adhesive for tile installation

Types of Hammers



Brick Hammer

Used to drive nails or strike chisels and break, cut, or chip masonry material.

Types of Hammers



Mason's Mash

Used to strike chisels when cutting masonry units.



Brick set- as wide as the brick it cuts



Brick Jointer

Used on the short vertical (head) joints.



Sled Runner-Used to tool the bed joints

Skatewheel Raker-Used for bed joints. Quickly forms neat hole free joints.



Hand Raker- used on joints the skate wheel raker will not reach

Mortar Pan

• Used to mix mortar.



Masonry Hoe

• Used to mix mortar and concrete.



Brick Tongs

• Used to carry brick.



Grout Bag

• Used to press mortar into mortar joints.



4 Foot Level

• Used to check level and plumb.



Torpedo Level

Used to check level and plumb in tight spaces.




Line or Corner Blocks

 Used to hold mason's line in place on bricks and blocks.



Standard Line Stretches

 Used to hold mason's line in place on bricks and blocks.



Hawk

• Used to carry mortar.




Sliding T-Bevel
